
TO: All Owners, Operators and Persons Responsible for businesses and organizations with indoor area facilities used for sports and recreational fitness activities located in the City of Kingston, and the Counties of Frontenac and Lennox & Addington, where organized sports are played or practised.

RE: LETTER OF INSTRUCTION made pursuant to Section 2 of Schedule 1 of Ontario Regulation 364/20: Rules for Areas at Step 3 and at Roadmap Exit Step.

I, Dr. Piotr Oglaza, Medical Officer of Health for Kingston, Frontenac and Lennox & Addington Public Health, rescind my **LETTER OF INSTRUCTION** made pursuant to Section 2 of Schedule 1 of Ontario Regulation 364/20: Rules for Areas at Step 3 and at the Roadmap for Exit Step, dated 2021-11-24, requiring proof of vaccination for those 12 to 17 years of age actively participating in organized sport, effective immediately.

All businesses and organizations shall continue to comply with all public health measures required under the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020*, including any successor legislation or applicable [regulations](#).
